

Be sure to wear your name tag. You may be sitting with someone you don't know in the morning but will have a new friend by afternoon.

Sewing machine--capable of doing zigzag and free-motion stitching--include manual and other accessories.

Zigzag or embroidery foot (open toe, if you have one) and free-motion (quilting) or darning foot.

Empty bobbin.

Bobbin Thread-- Metrolene or Superior Bottom Line (Janet will supply for class) and 60/2 or 50/3 cotton tread for piecing.

Size 70 or 90 machine needles (metafil, embroidery or sharp microtex)

Basic sewing equipment including fine point permanent marker and scissors (both paper and fabric scissors).

8: wooden embroidery hoop with 1/4: sides (optional)

For practice:

Two 12: rectangles off-white or other light colored fabric (muslin is OK).

Two 12: squares lightweight stabilizer.

Materials as called for on Garden Gems pattern package- fabric, lightweight paperbacked fusible, etc.

Embellishing Thread- Rayon or polyester thread or 60 wt cotton thread.

You will want to match petal and leaf colors in one or two values.

Other thread colors will depend on the flower you choose to embellish.
